It also provides data files for 2017 national, state, and continuum of care (CoC)-level point-in-time (PIT) count and Housing Inventory Count (HIC) estimates of homelessness, as well as estimates of chronically homeless persons, homeless veterans, and homeless children and youth.
2. The [Illinois Report Card](#) website provides rich information for public school districts, including dropout rate and chronically truant students (students who miss 5% of school days without a valid excuse). The latest available year is 2016–2017.
